RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MERCHANTVILLE,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY
MAINTENANCE COMMITMENT IN THE TRANSPORTATION
ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (NJDOT) APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Merchantville and Township of Pennsauken are preparing a grant application to the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation Enhancement Program for improvements to the West Maple Neighborhood;

WHEREAS, the West Maple Neighborhood is located between Route 130 and the Federal Street/Route 130 Overpass;

WHEREAS, Route 130 and the Federal Street/Route 130 Overpass significantly impact the vitality of the West Maple Neighborhood,

WHEREAS, the proposed activities will aesthetically improve West Maple Avenue, the primary thoroughfare into the West Maple Neighborhood from Route 130, by installing street trees, landscaping, and street furniture along the corridor.

WHEREAS, the TE Program will enhance the transportation experience for residents and visitors to the neighborhood, bolster the local economy, and improve the overall quality of life for the residents who live in the West Maple Neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Merchantville is committed to maintaining the street trees, landscaping, and street furniture that will be installed in the Borough of Merchantville pursuant to the Transportation Enhancement throughout their useful life.
