**ADDRESS NUMBERS**

Many times Police and emergency units responding to a crime, fire or medical emergency lose precious minutes locating an address that doesn't have a house or business number displayed. Other times, there is a displayed number but it's either painted over or hidden from view.

In an effort to reduce response time to emergency calls, residents and businesses are reminded to check and see if their number is clearly visible from the street at both day and night. Borough Ordinance 48 requires these numbers to be present and details what kind of numbers can be used and how and where to place them. We further recommend that reflectorized material be used, or the numbers be placed near a light.
