RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF
MERCHANTVILLE, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE
OF NEW JERSEY REGARDING THE RETIREMENT
STATUS OF POLICE SERGEANT MICHAEL FRANCIS
REILLY

WHEREAS, Police Sergeant Michael Francis Reilly (hereinafter, “Sgt. Reilly”) retired as a result of an ordinary disability retirement and, based upon the medical evidence, is totally and permanently disabled from the performance of his regular and assigned job duties as a police officer; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Reilly is physically or mentally incapacitated from the performance of his usual or any other duties that the Borough of Merchantville is able to offer him, and there are no other positions at the Borough available for this employee; and

WHEREAS, had the Borough of Merchantville know that Sgt. Reilly would not be granted accidental disability retirement benefits, the Borough would have filed an application for Involuntary Ordinary Disability Retirement on behalf of Sgt. Reilly; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Reilly has met all of the requirements for ordinary disability retirement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 43:16A-6;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Merchantville that, for all the reasons stated above, the request is hereby made

to the Police and Firemen's Retirement System that it treat the retirement of Police Sergeant Michael Francis Reilly as an Involuntary Ordinary Disability Retirement for all purposes.
